• **GAURA PURNIMA season:** February-May (4 months), issue published from **MONDAY JANUARY 13, 2025.** This may vary depending on our printer's Christmas break dates (yet to be confirmed).

- JANMASTAMI season: August (1 month in 2025), issue published from MONDAY JULY 7, 2025
- DIWALI season: October-January (4 months), issue published from MONDAY SEPTEMBER 8, 2025

We publish both online and in print. Paid advertising is available in our print edition only.

WRITING DEADLINES

Full pre-production for FOLK news takes 14 weeks. Writing deadlines fall 10 weeks before the first festival of the season.

Our 2024-5 writing deadlines are:

• 2025 GAURA PURNIMA season: FRI NOVEMBER 29, 2024. This may vary depending on our printer's Christmas break dates (yet to be confirmed).

2025 JANMASTAMI season: FRI MAY 23, 2025
 2025 DIWALI season: FRI JULY 25, 2025

WRITING GUIDELINES

Word Counts for Stories

2 pages (eg. a feature article including 1 small picture)	1,530 words
1 page (no picture)	825 words
1 page photo-essay	9 photos
1 page (eg. a normal article or a long report including 1 small picture)	750 words
1 page (including the maximum number of 4 pictures)	410 words
2/3 page (no picture)	460 words
½ page (eg. a short report including 1 small picture)	350 words
short story for Krishna's Kids	100 words
long story for Krishna's Kids	230 words

For each small picture that you wish include on the page, reduce your word count by 80 words.

GUIDELINES FOR PHOTOS OR GRAPHICS

We compose FOLK news using *InDesign* software. This allows us to adjust all the components of a page spread separately to create a clean, easy-to-read layout. We accept your own photos and graphics as long as they are of sufficient quality to print to the existing standard of our magazine.

Photo or graphic files should be

- **300dpi** at 1:1 scale to the actual size you require. Our pages are 197mm wide x 265mm high. The printable area is 173mm wide x 245mm high.
- Generally a file of *at least 2Mb* is sufficient.
- Print processing for colour images is **CMYK**
- We prefer to work with TIFF, PDF & JPEG images
